- ❑ Do 1 lesson from any Language Arts/Literature category on Moby Max each day (this does not include earned game time). Email Mrs. Allaman if you have forgotten your password.
- ❑ Do 1 lesson from No Red Ink each day. I will be checking on progress and adding more lessons if needed. Use your Google account to log in.
- ❑ Write a summary of your day (can do 1 for each day we are out of school). This can be like a journal if you wish.
- ❑ Summarize a tv show that you have watched for each day we are out of school.
- ❑ Find examples of figurative language throughout your days out of school and write them down in a notebook. Figurative Language definitions are attached. This can come from books, magazines, newspapers, tv shows, movies, or social media.

7th Grade Literature

- ❑ Read 1 chapter out of *Percy Jackson: The Lightning Thief* each day we are out of school, starting where we left off (Ch. 12). Write a summary for each chapter after you have finished reading it.
- ❑ Find and highlight (or underline) the vocabulary words (attached) in each chapter of *Percy Jackson: The Lightning Thief*. Write down what you think the word means by using context clues and then use a dictionary to check yourself. Do this with each chapter you read.
- ❑ Find examples of conflict in *Percy Jackson: The Lightning Thief*. Find examples of **person vs. person**, **person vs. nature**, and **person vs. society**. Try to find an example of at least 1 conflict in each chapter. Do 1 per day that you are home...you may use previous chapters as well.
