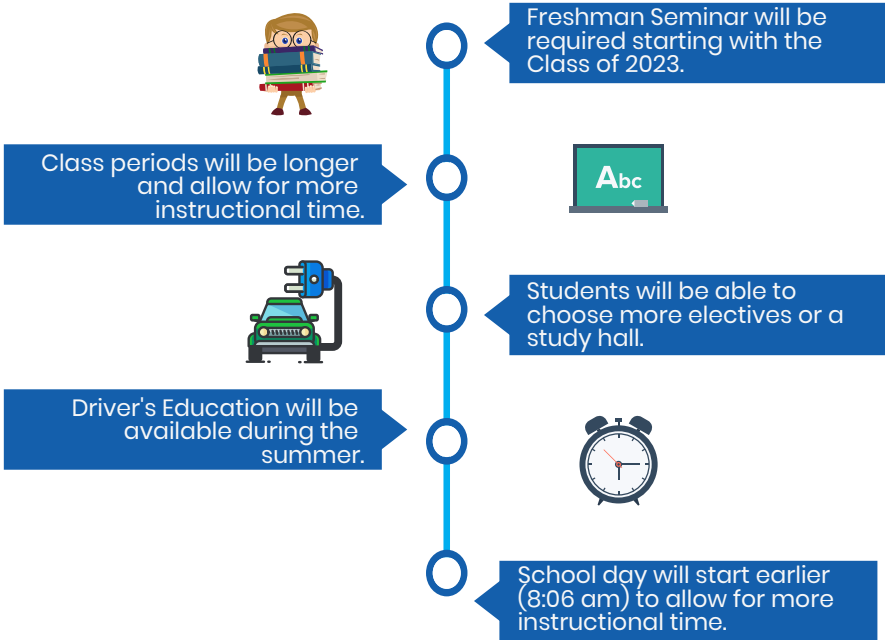




BUSHNELL-PRAIRIE CITY HIGH SCHOOL

CREDIT CHANGES

Class of 2020

Students who graduate in 2020 will be required to earn 28 credit units.

Class of 2021

Students who graduate in 2021 will be required to earn 26 credit units.

Class of 2022

Students who graduate in 2022 will be required to earn 24 credit units.

Class of 2023

Students who graduate in 2023 will be required to earn 24 credit units and successfully complete Freshman Seminar.
