

**QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS REGARDING AFTER SCHOOL SUPERVISION
FOR EARLY RELEASE WEDNESDAYS**

How much does it cost?

This opportunity is free to students who attend B-PC Elementary or B-PC Junior High.

What do I as a parent need to do?

In order to insure adequate supervision, parents must register their student for after school supervision. If you would like your student to participate, please fill out the enclosed permission slip and return it to either the Elementary or Junior High Office.

What will my child be doing during this time after school?

Students at the Elementary will go to the Cafeteria, while students at the Junior High will go to the Library where they will be able to play table games and/or work on homework. Students will be supervised by school personnel and are expected to follow established school rules to insure continued participation.

Will busing be provided for my child if he/she stays for the additional hour?

No, students will be dismissed for pick-up promptly at 3:10 pm at the Elementary and 3:00 pm at the Junior High.
