### Remote Learning Plan

*Remote learning days are designed and intended to support student engagement and learning. The District recognizes that individual families have been impacted by the pandemic that led to the development of remote learning days. The following guidelines have been developed:*

- No educational harm will come to any student as a result of remote learning.
- Learning activities will be provided to students with both a paper and online option for participation.
- Teachers will monitor and document student participation and completion of learning activities throughout the duration of remote learning.
- All learning activities will be evaluated using a “pass or incomplete” standard when activities have been completed/returned or upon students’ return to school.
- Students who receive an “incomplete” will be counseled individually to determine how remote learning activities can be completed.
- Teachers will continue to accept assignments not completed prior to remote learning days for credit.
- Teachers will maintain regular contact with students and parents/guardians during the duration of remote learning days.
- Special education teachers will maintain regular contact with students and parents/guardians during the duration of remote learning days to address individual student goals and objectives.
- Five (5) remote learning planning days are available and may be used throughout the duration of school closings. A remote learning planning day has been scheduled for April 7, 2020.
